RECRUITING FOR CULINARY - FOOD SERVICE **6-MONTH PAID WORK EXPERIENCE**

Curriculum: Upon successful completion of the program participants will:

-  Participate in a six-month paid work experience.
-  Earn a ServSafe food handler certificate.
-  Have a thorough understanding of food safety and sanitation practices.
-  Learn and use a variety of baking and cooking techniques, tools, and equipment.
-  Accurately follow a recipe.
-  Design, produce, and assemble attractive food displays.
-  Learn soft skills necessary to get and keep a job.
-  Work with an Employment Specialist to secure full or part-time employment after graduation.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Complete application form.
- Can work a 4-hour shift, five days per week (20 hours per week, Monday thru Friday).
- Have a mental health diagnosis and receive mental health services.
- Successful completion of orientation and in-person interview.
- Have a valid ID and Social Security Card.
- Age 18 and up.
- Be a resident of San Francisco.
- Proof of Covid-19 Vaccination, booster and current TB testing.
